

INVASIVES UPDATE

August 2025

North Pond

Infestation of curly-leaf pondweed was found in May 2024 and is wide-spread.

East Pond

The stream that connects East and North Ponds, The Serpentine, has been infested with curly-leaf pondweed since 2021.

Great Pond

Variable-leaf milfoil was found in Great Meadow Stream in 2010 and spread to North Bay, Swann's Brook, Rome Trout Brook, and Robbins Mill Stream and are all active management sites.

McGrath Pond

There are no known invasive aquatic plant infestations.

Long Pond


There are no known invasive aquatic plant infestations.

Messalonskee Lake

Variable-leaf milfoil has been in the lake and Belgrade Stream since the early 1990's. 7 Lakes became responsible for invasive species management of the lake in June 2025.

Salmon Lake

Eurasian water-milfoil was found in an isolated cove in 2008; Maine DEP conducted a one-time herbicide treatment in 2009 and it has not returned.
